### How do I download and view eBooks on EBSCO*host* on my computer through the web-based interface?

- 1. Sign in to your My EBSCOhost account.
  - If you don't yet have an account, create one at the EBSCOhost site:

- 2. Download an eBook title from EBSCO*host* by clicking on the "Download (offline)" link on the search result page or from within the detailed record.
- 3. Choose checkout period (1, 2, or 3 days).
- 4. Click "Checkout & Download".
  - 1. The eBook will be added to the **Checkouts** area of the folder.
- 5. When the dialog box opens, select **Open with** or **Save File**.
- 6. If you select **Open with**, your eBook will be opened with Adobe® Digital Editions.
- 7. If you select **Save file**, the eBook will be saved to your computer and can be opened with Adobe® Digital Editions at a later time.

### After you check-out and download your eBook:

- You may choose to transfer your eBook to your Adobe Digital Editions-compatible eBook Reader device.
- In order for a portable device to be used with eBooks on EBSCOhost, it must be
  compatible with Adobe Digital Editions. View a list of compatible devices here:
  http://blogs.adobe.com/digitalpublishing/supported-devices
- Once your e-book has been downloaded into Adobe Digital Editions, you will need to
  connect your portable device to the computer (generally via USB). Once connected,
  your device should show up in Adobe Digital Editions. At that point, drag and drop the
  e-book displayed onto your device to transfer.
- You can re-download the eBook from your My EBSCOhost folder at any time during your checkout period.

## Are downloaded eBooks automatically removed from my computer after the checkout has expired?

No, after an eBook checkout has expired, the downloaded eBook file can still be found in Digital Editions but cannot be opened. You must manually delete the file from Digital Editions to remove it from your computer. **Note**: This also applies to any portable devices (such as Apple or Android devices) to which you have transferred the eBook.

### Can I check-in my eBook before the end of the checkout period?

eBooks cannot be checked-in before the end of the checkout period. This is because eBook files can be transferred to various devices throughout the duration of the checkout period, and there is no way to ensure that the file is removed from these devices before it ends.

# Can I download EBSCO eBooks to an Apple device and read them using the Bluefire Reading app over a wireless connection?

eBooks can be downloaded and read using an Apple device (iPhone, iPod Touch, or iPad) using the Bluefire reading app available for free from iTunes.

**Note**: Your device must be running iOS 3.2 or higher.

### You will need the following:

Bluefire Reading App (Installed on your device)

An Adobe Digital Editions ID

### 1. Install Bluefire Reading App

- a. Install the Bluefire Reader Version 1.2 onto your device.
- b. Bluefire is available for free from iTunes at the following link:

### 2. Create an Adobe ID

- a. Create an Adobe Digital Editions ID at the following link:

b. **Note**: Before downloading an eBook, you must authorize the Bluefire app with your Adobe ID.

### 3. Check Out and Download an eBook

- a. Next, use the Safari browser on your device to access EBSCO eBooks and locate an eBook you would like to download to the device.
- b. To download an eBook:
  - Click the **Download (Offline)** link for the eBook you would like to download.
  - ii. If you are not logged into your My EBSCO*host* folder, you will be prompted to do so.
  - iii. Select a Check Out period from the drop-down menu and click the CheckOut & Download button.
  - iv. The eBook will be added to the **Check Outs** area of the folder.
  - v. When prompted, tap to open the eBook with the Bluefire app.
  - vi. The Bluefire app opens and begins downloading the book.
  - vii. After the eBook is finished downloading, select **Read Later** or **Read Now** to open your eBook and begin reading.
