

QUESTIONS ON OHIO LAWS

Use print resources:

1. Look up RC 3715.28 (ORC 3715.28). What is it about?
2. Look up RC 339.06 (ORC 339.06). What is it about? Has the law been changed in the pocket supplement? ALWAYS check the pocket supplement.
3. Look up RC 3119.021 (ORC 3119.021). What is it about?
4. What is the minimum age for marriage in Ohio? Give the citation where the answer can be found.

QUESTIONS ON OHIO COURT CASES

Use print resources:

1. What are the elements of actionable negligence? Start with the general index to Ohio Jurisprudence. What subject chapter and section numbers discuss this topic? _____ Look up that chapter in the main volumes. Notice that there is an outline at the beginning of the chapter. There is also an index at the end of the volume for each chapter in that volume. The outline and index can provide additional help when needed. Look at the outline for the sections you found above. Which of these section numbers discusses "foreseeability"? ____ Go to that section. There is a summary of the law on this topic. The footnotes at the bottom of the page give related court cases. Occasionally the cases are summarized. What is the name of a case involving damage to a driveway by a concrete truck? _____ What are the citations to the case?

Look at the beginning of this section at the Research References that give a West's Key Number Digest subject heading and section numbers. What are they for this section?

These can be used to find additional federal and Ohio cases by looking them up in either Federal Practice Digest or Ohio Digest. Encyclopedias are selective in listing cases. Digests list all cases. Find the appropriate chapter in Ohio Digest and look up the 2nd section number that was given in Ohio Jurisprudence. Find the last case listed under that section number (not including the pocket supplement). Give its name and citations.

Where can you find the actual case?

2. Where can you find a general discussion of Ohio law regarding aggravated murder? Give source, chapter and section(s).

Use LexisNexis Legal Research:

3. Look up 191 NE2d 279. What is the name of the case?

4. Find the Ohio case Lathrem vs. Foreman (most recent case of this title). What are all of the case's citations? Which of these do we have in print?
