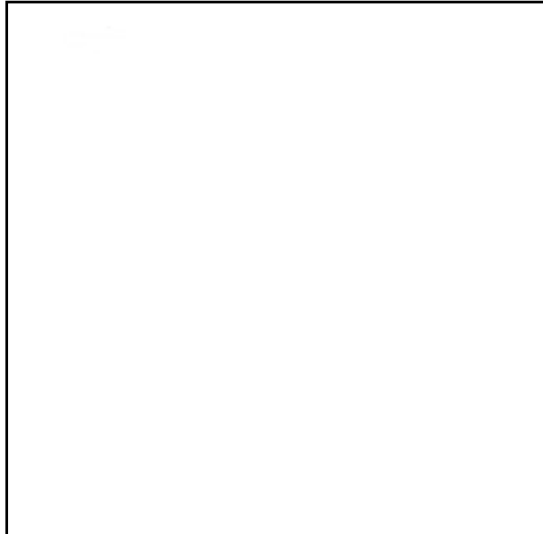

**1948, the hospital was named Wade MacMillan Hospital in recognition of Dr. Wade MacMillan, who was hired by Miami as Director of Student Health Services in 1918, and was the doctor at the hospital when it opened in 1923. It served as the university hospital until a new Student Health Center was opened in 1996. The building underwent a major renovation in 2001-2003 and today houses The Center for American and World Cultures.**
