<p>These four small brick buildings are located at the entrances to Yager Stadium and were moved to here in 1983. Two are at the southeast entrance on Bonham Road, and two are at the southwest entrance. They originally stood at the northwest corner of High Street and Patterson Avenue at the location of Miami Field (original football stadium, now gone). The buildings have a square plan, with low-pitched hipped roof covered with clay tile and capped by a ball finial. Exposed rafters are at the eaves. A decorative band of stone and brick below the eaves has medallions, shield and MIAMI FIELD inscribed in it. The dates '15, '16, '17, '18 are in the shield. Two brick-arched ticket windows have semicircular transoms and are covered by metal grilles. The interiors are lined with yellow brick.</p>				
43. History and Significance (Continue on Reverse if necessary)				
<p>The Miami Field Ticket Offices were originally part of a group of 5 that served as the gateway and ticket offices for Miami's original athletic stadium. They were placed in groups of 3 and 2 at the northwest corner of High and Patterson. The buildings in each grouping were connected by a breezeway roof supported by piers. The structures were built in 1920 and 1929 as memorials to two Miami University football players from the class of 1917 who were killed in WWI. They were dismantled in 1983 and four were relocated to the Yager Stadium entrances.</p>

<p>The ticket offices are located on Bonham Road at the north end of the Miami campus and occupy positions to either side of the main driveway entrance to Yager Stadium, Miami's football stadium.</p>

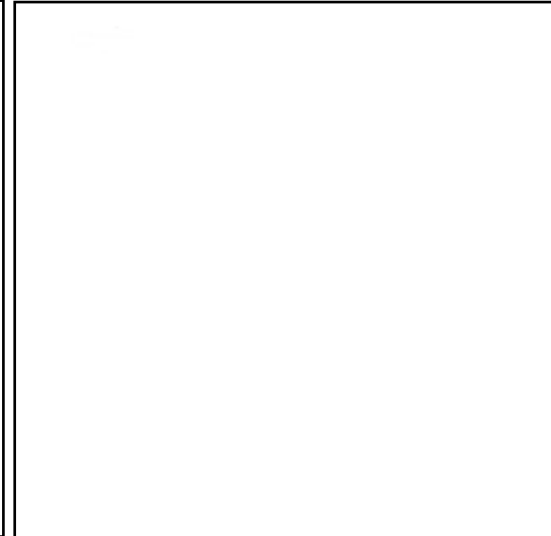
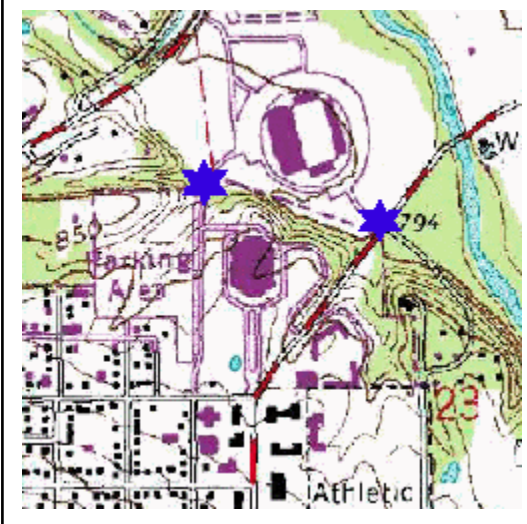
