

Specific Address or Location 751 Western College Drive Sawyer Gymnasium is a two-story rectangular brick building with flat roof. The facade has three bays, including a central round-arched entry located in a projecting one-story pavilion. The pavilion has a shaped gable design capped with stone and detailed with basket-weave patterned brick below the cap, header and soldier brick at the door arch, and diamond-shaped stone insets. Historic photos show that the parapet originally had sloped sides that terminated in a central rounded cap with window. This feature has been modified to the plain parapet roofline that exists today. Large windows with triple casement sash are located to either side of the central entrance. A continuous lintel course has a herringbone brick pattern. The entry retains its multi-paned round arched transom, but doors are replacements. A one-story shed-roofed addition occupies the building's north side. 43. History and Significance (Continue on Reverse if necessary) Built in 1913-1914, this building was constructed as the gymnasium and indoor swimming pool for Western College for Women. It may have originally been known simply as Western College Gymnasium, but was eventually named after Mary Alma Sawyer, dean of Western Female Seminary and Western College for Women from 1887 to 1920. A graduate of Mt. Holyoke Seminary in 1879, Miss Sawyer also served as acting president of the college from 1906-1908 and 1912-1914. This building was added to the campus during her second tenure as acting president. Sawyer Gymnasium served as the location for indoor sports, including basketball and swimming, as well as equipment for physical education courses. It also was the location for campus parties, and both formal and informal dances for many years 44. Description of Environment and Outbuildings (See #52) Located to the rear of Peabody hall, at the southeast corner of Miami University's Western campus. The setting has been compromised by the creation of a driveway and loading dock at the front entrance. 45. Sources of Information
