43. History and Significance (Continue on Reverse if necessary)

The Upper Campus Common has been open, undeveloped land since the founding of Miami University. Along with Slant Walk, it forms the primary northwest gateway into the university's historic academic core. The Common also occupies the same space as two town blocks set aside in the original Mile Square and Oxford village plat. Slant Walk has been in existence perhaps nearly as long as the campus; sources indicate that it originally extended to Elliott and Stoddard Halls. Slant Walk is mentioned in Walter Havighurst's The Miami Years as having been 'newly-bricked' in 1888. Sources indicate that the walk was paved with concrete in 1926-27. The memorial gateway was originally built as a Centennial project in 1908-09, but was replaced with the existing in 1973. These were given by Phi Delta Theta continued...


