This building was constructed in 1924 to serve the Western College for Women as a heating plant. The architect was G. W. Drach. The building was remodeled in 1963 and 1974. It is used by Miami University today as a maintenance facility.

44. Description of Environment and Outbuildings (See #52)

Located to the rear of Peabody Hall at the southeast corner of Miami University's Western campus. Today a large metal-skinned steam plant is located immediately to its south.


